RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION IN AN AMOUNT OF UP TO FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$500,000) AND TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE GRANT PROCEEDS OF UP TO FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$500,000) IN COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT COVID 19 PANDEMIC (“CDBG-CV”) FUNDS

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

- WHEREAS, As part of the CARES Act, the State of New Hampshire received approximately \$5.4 million of Community Development Block Grant Funds (CDBG-CV) to support eligible projects and initiatives to address the needs of primarily low and moderate income persons stemming from the Covid 19 “Coronavirus” Pandemic; and,
- WHEREAS, Of this total, approximately \$3.7 million is available to non-entitlement municipalities, as well as counties, for public services on a competitive basis; and,
- WHEREAS, the New Hampshire Community Development Finance Authority (NHC DFA) is the agency responsible for administering Community Development Block Grant funds in New Hampshire; and,
- WHEREAS, On July 20, 2020, the NHC DFA announced the programmatic rules and application procedures for CDBG-CV funds; and,
- WHEREAS, the City of Concord is eligible to apply to the NHC DFA for up to \$500,000 in CDBG-CV funding to support local non-profit organizations which provide public services to primarily low and moderate income persons associated with the Covid 19 “Coronavirus” Pandemic; and,
- WHEREAS, the City desires to apply for CDBG-CV funds to support the Friendly Kitchen, Concord Coalition to End Homelessness, Family Promise, the Friends Program, and the City of Concord in their respective efforts to provide public services to primarily low and moderate income persons associated with the Covid 19 “Coronavirus” Pandemic; and,
- WHEREAS, this appropriation is for a purpose not included in the adopted budget, therefore, section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-third vote of the City Council.

2. Said revenue shall be available as follows:

CDBG Fund
CDBG-CV Grant.....\$500,000

3. That the City Council approves this Community Development Block Grant application and hereby authorizes the City Manager to submit the necessary grant documents and to accept, administer, and spend said CDBG funds for the purposes described herein upon approval by the NH Community Development Finance Authority.
4. Sums as appropriated shall be expended under the direction of the City Manager.
5. This resolution shall take effect upon its passage and grant award.
