- the City wishes to proceed with this project and has secured the required WHEREAS, funding to do so; and
- the \$300,000 contribution from Friends of Merrimack Greenway Trail WHEREAS, (FMRGT) is comprised of \$150,000 in FMRGT donations and \$150,000 in Merrimack County grant funds received by FMRGT; and
- City Council authorized the City Manager to apply for the Land and Water WHEREAS, Conservation Fund (LWCF) grant on October 13, 2020 (Resolution #9322); and
- WHEREAS, a match is required for the LWCF grant in the amount of \$275,000, which is met with \$130,000 in City issued general obligation bonds and \$145,000 in FMRGT donations; and
- RSA 33:9 mandates that a two-thirds vote of all members of the City Council is WHEREAS, required to pass a bond resolution; and
- WHEREAS, this appropriation is for a purpose for which funds were not included in the Fiscal Year 2024 adopted budget, therefore Section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council.

2) Revenue to meet said appropriation shall be provided from the following sources:

Land and Water Conservation Fund grant	\$275,000
Friends of Merrimack River Greenway Trail donation	\$300,000
Total	\$705,000

- 3) In order to meet said expenditure, the City Treasurer, with approval of the City Manager, is authorized to issue \$130,000 in bonds and notes of the City of Concord in accordance with RSA 33:9.
- 4) The discretion of the fixing of dates, maturities, rate of interest, form and other details of such bonds and notes (including whether such bonds or notes shall be issued on a tax exempt or taxable basis) and providing for the sale are hereby delegated to the City Treasurer.
- 5) The useful life of the project is expected to be in excess of twenty (20) years.
- 6) Sums as appropriated shall be expended under the direction of the City Manager.
- 7) This resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
