**WHEREAS**, the Concord Police Department has received notification from the Department of

Safety - Homeland Security and Emergency Management Exercise and Evaluation Program that the City of Concord has been approved to receive funding in the amount of \$22,400 to conduct a Homeland Security Exercise; and

**WHEREAS,** the Concord City Council approved Resolution #8877, adopted November 9,

2015, at their regular meeting authorizing the City Manager to apply for the

above grant; and

**WHEREAS,** Concord Hospital and the Concord School District has requested the assistance of

the Concord Police Department in training and participation in an active shooter

exercise; and

**WHEREAS,** Concord Hospital and Concord School District desire to utilize this exercise to

assess the emergency response to such an incident, and this exercise will be conducted both on Concord Hospital and Concord School District grounds; and

**WHEREAS,** the Concord Police Department, in conjunction with the Concord Fire

Department and Central NH Special Operations Unit desire to utilize this exercise to assess the response and interoperability capabilities of each agency in an active

shooter incident, and

**WHEREAS,** there is no financial match required for this grant program; and

WHEREAS, this appropriation is for a purpose not included in the Fiscal Year 2016 adopted

budget, therefore Section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the

City Council.
