Subject: Commitment to Fundraising for Snowmaking Utilities Extension at Beaver Meadow

Dear Members of the Concord City Council,

As representative of **SkiTheBeav**, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit dedicated to enhancing cross-country skiing facilities at the Beaver Meadow Municipal Golf Course (BMGC), I write to provide a formal commitment regarding the necessary infrastructure for snowmaking at this valuable community facility. As we have previously shared, our organization believes that with the right investment in snowmaking capability, Beaver Meadow is ideally situated to become a central hub for cross-country skiing in central New Hampshire.

To facilitate this vision and minimize the tax burden on our fellow residents, SkiTheBeav is prepared to fundraise the entire cost of the utility's extension required for snowmaking operations.

This commitment specifically includes the additional **\$14,472** required for the installation of a **three-phase transformer**, as well as all associated labor costs that were not accounted for in the original project estimate (\$42,825), which brings the total cost of extending water and electric utilities at the site to \$57,297.

Our organization has spent years working toward the moment when Beaver Meadow can offer consistent high-quality skiing conditions all winter long. We look forward to continuing our productive relationship with the Golf Course and the Parks and Recreation Department to make this year-round vision a reality, and doing so in a manner that doesn't increase property tax burden for the community.
