AND POLICE COMMAND STAFF.

## The City of Concord resolves as follows:

**WHEREAS,** the Concord Fire Department received notification from the State of New

Hampshire about the expected availability of funds through the FEMA Homeland

Security Grant Program; and

**WHEREAS.** the City of Concord desires to conduct an active shooter table-top exercise with the

Fire and Police Department command staff through the use of these funds; and

**WHEREAS,** the City of Concord could substantially benefit from this exercise.

## NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:

- 1. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to apply for funding through the FEMA Homeland Security Grant Program when it becomes available.
- 2. This resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
