**RESOLUTION** AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE GRANITE UNITED WAY AS OUTLINED IN ITS CURRENT GRANT PROGRAM,

*The City of Concord resolves as follows:*

**WHEREAS,** the City of Concord is eligible to apply for grant funding through the Granite United Way as outlined in its current grant program; and

**WHEREAS,** the City of Concord by way of its Police Department desires to continue its work with the Adverse Childhood Experiences Response Team (ACERT). The team will continue to visit families who have experienced incidents, when police are requested for service, where children may have been exposed to violence, or other adverse childhood experiences. The team will assess the situation and determine next steps and referrals that can be made for the child and family. The program will continue during the remainder of 2024 and through the summer of 2025; and

**WHEREAS,** the City of Concord by way of its Police Department desires to continue this valuable relationship with Granite United Way. ACERT allows us to have early intervention with families and children experiencing violence or traumatic events; and

**WHEREAS,** funds are available through the Granite United Way.

***NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Concord that:***

1. That the City Council authorizes the City Manager to submit the necessary grant application documents.
2. That this resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
