SUBJECT: Supplemental report removing permit fees for outdoor seating and sandwich board signs from the proposed FY 21 schedule of fees

Recommendation

Accept this supplemental report removing outdoor seating and sandwich board fees from the proposed schedule of ordinance and non-ordinance based fees submitted for Council public hearing in April.

Background

Staff presented City Council with a report at its February meeting that recommended consideration of a \$50 fee for outdoor seating on public property and a \$25 fee for sandwich boards. Council opted to convene an ad hoc committee to review this matter. That committee met on March 2nd and did not recommend establishing permit fees at this time. A full report on the Committee's findings and recommendations will be submitted as part of the April agenda.

Discussion

Staff has revised the proposed ordinance to remove the two fees in question and provided Council with a revised schedule for its April public hearing.
