Dear Jim,

I hope this email finds you well. I am writing to request your assistance in addressing/reviving an ongoing concern regarding traffic conditions on Iron Works Rd.

I first discussed this issue with Concord's Traffic Operations Committee (TOC) pre-pandemic, and a planned traffic study in 2020 was tabled until traffic levels returned to post-pandemic levels.

The road continues to be a popular cut-through route from 89 to 93, leading to heightened traffic and speed, especially on Sunday evenings. To better understand and address these issues, I kindly request that you bring this matter to the attention of the Traffic Operations Committee again and advocate for a traffic study on Iron Works Rd that includes Sunday conditions.

As you know, our ultimate goal is the installation of a sidewalk along Iron Works Rd and potentially lowering the speed limit to 25 mph. We hope this data will shed light on that need.
