**SUBJECT:** General Code Ordinance Amendment – Sewer and Drains

### **Recommendation**

Accept this report and set attached Ordinance amending to Code of Ordinances, Title I, General Code; Chapter 9, Water, Article 9-6 (various sections) for public hearing on April 13, 2026.

### **Background**

The City of Concord's Wastewater Division in cooperation with the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services (NHDES) recently completed a review of the City's Sewer Use Ordinance. This review was initiated due to changes in both State and Federal regulations which influence the city's Sewer Use Ordinance. As a result of this review several sections of the current ordinance were identified for updating as outlined in the attached ordinance amendment prepared by the City Solicitor.

### **Discussion**

These changes to the Sewer Use Ordinance are a regulatory requirement. Not completing the Sewer Use Ordinance change would trigger NHDES issuing a violation to the City for non-compliance.

As a result, the City of Concord must update the Sewer Use Ordinance to comply with applicable State and Federal requirements.
