SUBJECT: Report from the Traffic Engineer on behalf of the Transportation Policy Advisory Committee in response to a referral from Councilor Champlin regarding a constituent request for a painted crosswalk on Storrs Street at Dixon Avenue.

Recommendation

Accept this report.

Background

On June 2, 2017, Councilor Champlin forwarded to the City Clerk a request from a downtown merchant to install a crosswalk on Storrs Street at Dixon Avenue. City Council referred this request to the Transportation Policy Advisory Committee (TPAC) on June 12, 2017.

A similar request had been considered by the Traffic Operations Committee (TOC) on March 21, 2017, at which time TOC endorsed the painting of a crosswalk at this location on the northern leg of Storrs Street. At the time, General Services indicated the crosswalk would be painted during the city-wide pavement marking program this spring. The crosswalk markings along Storrs Street, including this new location, were painted on June 12, 2017.

This referral and staff follow-up were also reviewed by TPAC on June 22, 2017.
