RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE FLYING YANKEE RESTORATION GROUP'S MISSION TO RELOCATE THE HISTORICAL FLYING YANKEE STREAMLINER TRAIN TO THE CITY OF CONCORD.

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the Flying Yankee Restoration Group, Inc. (FYRG), a tax-exempt organization,

> has requested a partnership with the City of Concord to relocate the Flying Yankee Streamliner Train from its current location in Lincoln, New Hampshire,

to the City of Concord; and

WHEREAS, the FYRG met with the City Manager on February 24, 2016, to discuss the City's

potential interest in the possibility of relocating the Flying Yankee Streamliner

Train to Concord: and

WHEREAS, there is a historical significance to locating the Flying Yankee Streamliner Train

in Concord, as it was maintained by local workers at the South Concord railroad

shops from 1935 to 1957; and

WHEREAS, relocation of the Flying Yankee Streamliner Train in Concord will be a catalyst

for tourism-related economic development;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:

- 1. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to establish a partnership with the Flying Yankee Restoration Group, Inc. in support of their mission to relocate the Flying Yankee Streamliner Train to the City of Concord.
- 2. This resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
