Detective DeAngelis began his career in 1999 as a Police Officer and served in the Patrol Division until being assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division as the Property/Evidence Officer in 2004; and

WHEREAS, In 2008 Detective DeAngelis was reassigned to the Youth Services Unit as an Investigator and remained in this position until his retirement on November 30, 2019.
