**RESOLUTION**      FIXING AND DETERMINING THE AMOUNT OF MONEY TO BE APPROPRIATED BY THE CITY OF CONCORD FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2026 ENDING JUNE 30, 2026 FOR THE GENERAL FUND, SPECIAL REVENUE FUNDS, ENTERPRISE FUNDS, DEBT SERVICE FUNDS, AND DE MINIMIS ACCOUNTS

**WHEREAS,**            the fiscal year 2026 budget as provided and summarized below; and

**WHEREAS,**            the fiscal year 2026 budget provides for the operations, maintenance, improvements, payment of debt service, and transfers; and

**WHEREAS,**            Section 34 of the City Charter requires the City Manager to submit the budget to the City Council at least forty-five (45) days before the start of the fiscal year of the budget;

**The City of Concord resolves as follows:**
