WHEREAS,	the City of Concord maintains traffic signals at 54 intersections; and		
WHEREAS,	over the past year, critical components at some intersections have failed and temporary emergency repairs were made to keep the intersections in operation; and		
WHEREAS,	staff have worked with one of the City's on-call engineering consultants to perform structural inspection of traffic signal mast arms that are estimated to be 25-years of age, or older; and		
WHEREAS,	results of this inspection effort revealed the need to replace critical components of traffic signal infrastructure located at the intersections of North State/Centre Streets and North Main/Washington/Ferry Streets; and		
WHEREAS,	the total estimated cost of traffic signal improvements is \$1,053,000; and		
WHEREAS,	the sum of \$71,830 was previously appropriated for traffic signal improvements at the North Main/Washington/Ferry Street intersections, and remains available to support this project; and		
WHEREAS,	additionally the State/Pleasant Intersection subproject (CIP #283) is complete and the sum of \$101,221.97 is available for repurposing; and		
WHEREAS,	the useful life of the traffic signal infrastructure is equal to or exceeds the term of the bond funds being repurposed; and		
WHEREAS,	this repurposing of bond proceeds requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council under
