RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF FORTY THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE DOLLARS AND THIRTY-NINE CENTS (\$40,565.39) FOR THE REIMBURSEMENT OF PERSONNEL COSTS RELATED TO THE DEPLOYMENT OF FIRE DEPARTMENT PERSONNEL TO AREAS IMPACTED BY NATURAL DISASTERS AND ACCEPTING THE SUM OF FORTY THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE DOLLARS THIRTY-NINE CENTS (\$40,565.39) FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, Fire Department personnel have been deployed to areas impacted by natural disasters, which was not part of the Fiscal Year 2020 budget; and

WHEREAS, Fire Department overtime compensation and related fringe benefit accounts are projected to be over-expended before the end of Fiscal Year 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Concord Fire Department has requested reimbursements from the Federal Emergency Management Agency in the amount of \$40,565.39; and

WHEREAS, the Concord Fire Department desires to utilize this funding to offset overtime compensation and related fringe benefits; and

WHEREAS, there is no financial match required for these monies; and

WHEREAS, this appropriation is for a purpose not included in the Fiscal Year 2020 adopted budget, therefore Section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:

1. The sum of\$40,565.39
be and is hereby appropriated as follows:

General Fund
Compensation and fringe benefits\$40,565.39

2. Revenue to meet said appropriation shall be provided from the following source:

General Fund
Federal Emergency Management Agency reimbursement.....\$40,565.39

3. Sums as appropriated shall be expended under the direction of the City Manager.
4. The resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
