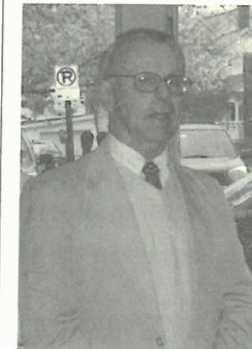
BUSKERS INDOORS

Three years ago we ended our season with just such a performance and it was well received. Enjoy the evening and we will see you all in September with a brand-new season of entertainment.

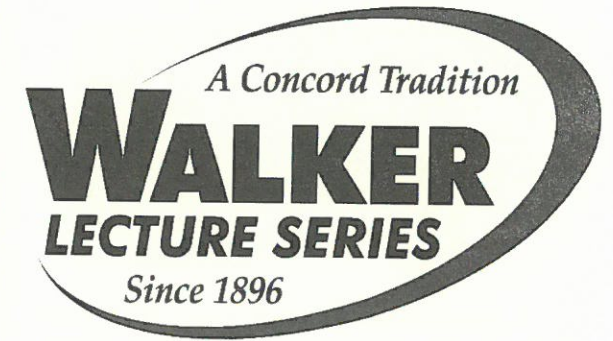
