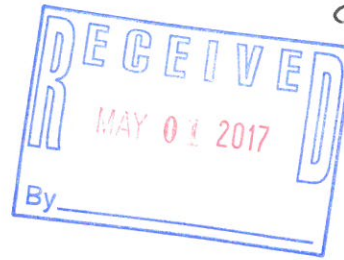

RE: Request for closure of Capitol Street for the 11th Annual Concord Multicultural Festival

Event Date and Time: Saturday, June 24, 2017, 2:00pm – 6:00pm

Please consider this request, on behalf of the Concord Multicultural Festival, for the use of Capitol Street for the 11th Annual Concord Multicultural Festival. The event will take place from 2:00pm – 6:00pm with performances, activities and non-selling vendors on the State House lawn and plaza, and food and craft vendors on Capitol Street.

We are requesting a street closure for Capitol Street from North Main to North State Street following the Concord Farmers Market from 1:00pm until 8:00pm to accommodate our food and craft vendors and Festival attendees.
