The City of Concord resolves as follows:

- WHEREAS,** in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriation Act, 2021 (CRRSA) was passed by Congress and signed into law by President Trump on December, 27, 2020; and
- WHEREAS,** Title IV of CRRSA provides approximately \$2 billion in economic relief to airports to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the COVID-19 pandemic, including relief from rent and minimum annual guarantees (MAG) for eligible airport concessions at primary airports; and
- WHEREAS,** the City of Concord was deemed eligible to receive \$13,000 in CRRSA Act funding for the general operations and maintenance of the Concord Municipal Airport for expenses incurred since January 20, 2020; and
- WHEREAS,** these funds would be administered by the New Hampshire Department of Transportation Bureau of Aeronautics on behalf of the CRRSA Act; and
- WHEREAS,** the City Manager's application to receive these funds was submitted to New Hampshire Department of Transportation Bureau of Aeronautics on March 5, 2021; and
- WHEREAS,** the City is scheduled to receive these funds in mid-April 2021; and
- WHEREAS,** the Airport will use these dollars for eligible repairs & maintenance, building supplies and professional service expenses; and
- WHEREAS,** there is no financial match required for this grant; and
- WHEREAS,** the City has until May 25, 2024 to seek reimbursement for allowable costs; and
- WHEREAS,** this appropriation is for a purpose for which funds were not included in the Fiscal Year 2021 adopted budget, therefore section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council.
