### **Recommendations:**

### **Background:**

In the FY 2025 City budget, City Council allocated \$150,000 for event funding, to be distributed to organizations holding new and free public events in Concord.

### **Discussion:**

The City received several requests for event funding. A committee made up of City staff met and reviewed the proposals. The following grants were rewarded:

- Intown Concord - First Friday: \$8,000
- Wayfarer Coffee Roasters - Northeast Coffee Festival: \$20,000
- New Hampshire Book & Literary Festival, Inc.: \$20,000
- Concord Community Music School - Wagner's Women Concert: \$4,712
- Rattlebox Studio, LLC - Kids Music Fest: \$10,000
- Capital Center for the Arts - Community Concerts: \$15,000
- Kimball Jenkins Estate - Holidays at the Estate: A Celebration of the Season: \$25,000
- Concord Community Music School - New England Roots & Branches II: \$4,163
