RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT FROM UNITIL IN THE AMOUNT OF UP TO TWENTY-TWO THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$22,300) AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF UP TO TWENTY-TWO THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$22,300) FOR THE INSTALLATION OF LED LIGHTING AT THE COMBINED OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE FACILITY AS PART OF THE 2018 LED LIGHTING SUBPROJECT (CIP #323)

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the City Council authorized the issuance of \$25,000 in general obligation

bonds and notes as part of its Fiscal Year 2018 adopted budget (Resolution #9008), for the installation of LED lighting at the Combined Operations

and Maintenance Facility (COMF) as part of CIP #323; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of this project is expected to be approximately \$44,600, of

which 50% (\$22,300) will be a direct grant to the vendor from Unitil and

the remaining 50% (\$22,300) will be funded using the previous

appropriation, leaving a contingency of \$2,700; and

WHEREAS, this supplemental appropriation addresses the Unitil grant as an additional

funding source; and

WHEREAS, this appropriation is for a purpose not included in the Fiscal Year 2019

adopted budget, therefore Section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-

thirds vote of the City Council.

NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:
