**SUBJECT:** Authorization to Accept Monetary Gift totaling \$124.06 for use on the City trails as provided for under the preauthorization granted by City Council

### Recommendation

It is recommended that City Council approve the acceptance and expenditure of the monetary gift to the City of Concord Conservation Commission for the purposes indicated.

### Background

Ezekiel (Zeke) Gentchos is in the process of achieving his Eagle Scout, and approached the Conservation Commission with a proposal to work on the City trails for his project. Upon approval of the proposal to construct a plank walk and to stabilize sections of the Winant Trail, Zeke raised money for construction materials and organized a construction day with other volunteers. Zeke recently completed the project and donated the remaining funds for use on future trail projects.



### Discussion

Upon the City Council's approval, the Conservation Commission, with input from the Trails Subcommittee, will utilize the funds towards improvements on the City trails.
