RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF ELEVEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$11,000) IN THE GRANITE UNITED WAY GRANT PROJECT FOR TRAINING IN ADVERSE CHILDHOOD EXPERIENCES (ACES) AND ACCEPTING THE SUM OF ELEVEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$11,000) FROM THE GRANITE UNITED WAY FOR THIS PURPOSE

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

- WHEREAS, the Concord Police Department requested and was granted approval to apply for funding through the Granite United Way for training in Adverse Childhood Experience (ACES) at the June 10, 2024 City Council meeting; and
- WHEREAS, the Concord Police Department has received notification from the Granite United Way that we have been awarded a grant in the amount of up to \$11,000.00; and
- WHEREAS, these funds have been designated by the Granite United Way to be applied towards ACES training; and
- WHEREAS, there is no financial match required by the City; and
- WHEREAS, this appropriation is for a purpose for which funding was not included in the Fiscal Year 2025 adopted budget, therefore Section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of City of Concord that:

1. The sum of\$11,000.00
be and is hereby appropriated as follows:
- Grants & Donations Fund
Granite United Way ACES Training expenses.....\$11,000.00
2. Revenue to meet said appropriation shall be provided from the following source:
- Grants & Donations Fund
Granite United Way ACES Training grant funds\$11,000.00
3. Sums as appropriated shall be expended under the direction of the City Manager.
4. This resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
