SUBJECT: Lead Service Line Inventory Grant Authorization Appropriation

Recommendation

Accept this report and set the attached resolution accepting and appropriating the sum of \$75,000 from the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services (NHDES) Lead Service Line Inventory Grant for a public hearing on February 13, 2023.

Background

The General Services Department (the Department) has been working with the NHDES to secure funding for federally required Lead Service Line Inventory program. This requirement comes from the outfall of Flint Michigan and the issues it brought to light with older Lead containing service lines. In 2022 the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) established regulation requiring all water systems throughout the US to create an inventory of all service line locations, and their respective materials, available and searchable for the public to review.

Discussion

The Department has identified the information sources to gather the needed data and a plan to gather information on the ones we have limited records for. The NHDES grant of up to \$75,000 will help Concord offset the expenses associated with gathering the data and presenting it to the public in a searchable format.
