RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF FIFTEEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED THIRTY-SIX DOLLARS AND NINETY-FOUR CENTS (\$15,536.94) TO FUND FIFTY PERCENT OF BALLISTIC VEST PURCHASES MADE BY THE CONCORD POLICE DEPARTMENT AND ACCEPTING THE SUM OF FIFTEEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED THIRTY-SIX DOLLARS AND NINETY-FOUR CENTS (\$15,536.94) FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE – OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS - BULLETPROOF VEST PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the City of Concord has received approval from the US Department of Justice – Office of Justice Programs – Bulletproof Vest Partnership Program to receive funding in the amount of \$15,536.94 to offset 50% of the costs of the Department’s purchase of new ballistic vests; and

WHEREAS, the Concord City Council approved Resolution #9188, adopted May 13, 2019, at their regular meeting authorizing the City Manager to apply for the above grant program; and

WHEREAS, the Department anticipates purchasing ballistic vests over the course of the upcoming twelve months; and

WHEREAS, the City of Concord has appropriated the matching 50% funding of these vests through CIP #370; and

WHEREAS, this appropriation is for a purpose not included in the FY 2020 budget, therefore section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:
