SUBJECT: Intown Concord is requesting approval and a permit for the Serving and Consumption of Alcoholic Beverages on City Property during Concord Market Days, June 25, 26, 27, 2015 as outlined by Ordinance Chapter 15 Article 15-12; Licensing of Alcohol use on City Property. This will be for beer and wine only.

Recommendation

As there were no incidents or problems for the past three years, staff recommends approval of the license applications and issuance of permits as applied for by Intown Concord for Concord Market Days.

Background

This is Intown Concord's fourth year for this request. Ordinance 15-12-5 (a) requires approval by the City Council and that the City Manager sign the application for the issuance of a license to serve alcohol on closed city streets.

Discussion

The license applications include the Certificate of Management Training Seminar Issued by the State of NH Liquor Commission, three (3) "one Day Liquor Licenses" issued by the State Liquor Commission, the list of servers, the layout of the service area with map, and the required Insurance Policy. The Health & Licensing Officer has reviewed and approved each application.
