RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF TWENTY-ONE THOUSAND, SIX HUNDRED EIGHTEEN DOLLARS (\$21,618) IN UNMATCHED GRANT FUNDS FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM , FUNDS DESIGNATED FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT RELATED PROGRAMS

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the Concord Police Department has received notification from the Unites States Department of Justice, Office of Justice Assistance, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program, that we have been awarded a grant in the amount of twenty-one thousand, six hundred eighteen dollars (\$21,618); and

WHEREAS, the Concord Police Department desires to procure police equipment and training in the amount of \$18,618; and

WHEREAS, there is no match required for accepting these funds; and

WHEREAS, the Concord Police Department is entering into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Merrimack County to pass through the remaining \$3,000 to the County; and

WHEREAS, this appropriation is for a purpose not included in the Fiscal Year 2018 adopted budget, therefore section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:
