Subject: **Parking Ordinance Amendments (No Parking Restrictions, Church Street between Jackson and Lyndon Streets)**

Recommendation:

Set the attached ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances; Title II, Traffic Code; Chapter 18, Parking, Article 18-1, Stopping, Standing and Parking, Section 18-1-7.1(a), Parking Prohibited During Certain Hours and Months in Designated Places, Schedule IX, for public hearing on September 14, 2026 and *if adopted, remove the prior ordinance from the table and vote to reject it.*

Background:

Please see attached report dated April 13, 2026 for background on the original ordinance proposal.

The ordinance proposed and considered by the City Council on May 11, 2026, was tabled, and then re-referred to the Parking Committee.

Discussion:

Staff reviewed request with the Parking Committee and residents of the area on June 22, 2026 (see attached Committee draft meeting minutes). The committee voted to direct Staff to complete the attached ordinance which would amend the Parking Ordinance to establish a winter season parking restriction on the north side of the road from Jackson Street to Lyndon Street, replacing the previously proposed ordinance which would have extended no parking at all times on the north side of Church Street from Jackson Street to Rumford Street.
