WHEREAS, the City is the owner of certain real estate located on Village Street, City

Assessor's Parcel #143-P-31, consisting of 2.2 +/- acres of land, as further described by a deed recorded at the Merrimack County Registry of Deeds

Book 540 Page 517; and,

WHEREAS, the City desires to sell this property to; and,

WHEREAS, on May 11, 2015, the City Council approved Resolution #8842 which

authorized the City Manager to sell said property to the Penacook

Community Center, Inc., or its successors, heirs, or assigns, for the purpose

of developing a community center; and,

WHEREAS, the Purchase and Sales Agreement expired on December 1, 2016; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to renew and extend the Purchase and Sale

Agreement in order to give the Penacook Community Center ample time to

pursue their project.

NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Concord that:

- 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to renew and extend the expired Purchase and Sale Agreement, including the autonomy to negotiate termination dates, and potential future extensions thereto, for the renewed Agreement.
- 2. This resolution shall take effect upon passage.
