The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the Concord Police Department has received notification from the New Hampshire Department of Safety Law Enforcement Opioid Abuse Reduction Initiative that the City of Concord has been approved to receive funding in the amount of \$62,551 designated to cover overtime costs associated with implementing enhanced strategies focused on addressing the illegal drug/opioid crisis facing the City; and

WHEREAS, the Concord City Council approved Resolution #9000, adopted June 12, 2017, at their regular meeting authorizing the City Manager to apply for the above grant; and

WHEREAS, the Concord Police Department desires to utilize this funding to cover overtime costs associated with augmenting the Department's efforts in combatting the illegal drug/opioid crisis facing the City and surrounding communities; and

WHEREAS, there is no financial match required for this grant program; and

WHEREAS, this appropriation is for a purpose not included in the Fiscal Year 2018 adopted budget, therefore Section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council.

NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:
