WHEREAS, the Department anticipates purchasing ballistic vests over the course of the upcoming twelve months; and
WHEREAS, the City of Concord is anticipating an FY 2016 CIP appropriation of the matching 50% funding of these vests through CIP #370; and
WHEREAS, this appropriation is for a purpose not included in the FY 2016 adopted budget, therefore section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council;
