SUBJECT: Opioid Receipt of \$4,971.12

#### Recommendation

Accept this report and authorize the use of the \$4,971.12 receipt of Opioid funds as a transfer to the Opioid reserve under the Diminimus gifts and donations authorization and retroactive to June 30, 2023.

# Background

On May 9, 2023, the City received a payment in the amount of \$4,971.12 from the State of New Hampshire regarding the Opioid Litigation Settlement Fund Distribution Pursuant to RSA 126-A:83, II.

## Discussion

An Opioid Abatement Reserve Fund in conjunction with the Opioid Litigation Settlement was established by the City Council in July 2021 to set these funds aside for the City Council to best determine how and when to appropriate. Including the receipt of the \$4,971.12, the City has now received a total of \$218,998.20.
