I hope this email finds you well. I understand that some time in January meters will finally be installed at the North end of Storrs St. To be very clear I am pro meter in this area and for much of Storrs St. for that matter.

A retail business however, my preference would be for 2 hour or 3 hour meters directly in front of 137 Storrs St. (i.e. retail meters) instead of 10-hour meters (i.e. office meters). Of the 20 or so spots in that area, having 4-6 as "retail" meters would improve turnover, generate similar revenues (perhaps more with citations) and these spaces would still be available to residential tenants overnight for free.

If you could convey this request to the parking committee it would be appreciated.
