The City of Concord resolves as follows:		
WH	EREAS,	in March 2021, the Hall Street treatment facility experienced a mechanical failure inside the facility's chlorination building which resulted in the release of approximately 4,000 gallons of sodium hypochlorite and was contained within the specially designed spill containment berm; and
WH	EREAS,	as a result of the spill and the age of the existing structure, several small leaks and delamination of the berms protective coating occurred and need to be repaired; and
WH	EREAS,	the Fiscal Year 2021 Capital Improvement Plan did not include any money for an emergency repair of a chemical containment berm; and
WH	EREAS,	the Department has identified available funds in the amount of \$53,455.06 in the completed Fiscal Year 2021 Screw Pump Repair subproject (CIP #104); and
WH	EREAS,	the department anticipates the cost of the repair to the berm to be approximately \$30,000; and
WH	EREAS,	this repurposing of bond proceeds requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council under RSA 33:3-a, II.
