

# CITY OF CONCORD

**RESOLUTION** REPURPOSING THE SUM OF FIFTY-THREE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE DOLLARS AND SIX CENTS (\$53,455.06) FROM THE COMPLETED FISCAL YEAR 2021 SCREW PUMP REPAIR SUBPROJECT (CIP #104) TO A NEW CONTAINMENT BERM REPAIR SUBPROJECT (CIP #104)

**The City of Concord resolves as follows:**

**WHEREAS,** in March 2021, the Hall Street treatment facility experienced a mechanical failure inside the facility’s chlorination building which resulted in the release of approximately 4,000 gallons of sodium hypochlorite and was contained within the specially designed spill containment berm; and

**WHEREAS,** as a result of the spill and the age of the existing structure, several small leaks and delamination of the berms protective coating occurred and need to be repaired; and

**WHEREAS,** the Fiscal Year 2021 Capital Improvement Plan did not include any money for an emergency repair of a chemical containment berm; and

**WHEREAS,** the Department has identified available funds in the amount of \$53,455.06 in the completed Fiscal Year 2021 Screw Pump Repair subproject (CIP #104); and

**WHEREAS,** the department anticipates the cost of the repair to the berm to be approximately \$30,000; and

**WHEREAS,** this repurposing of bond proceeds requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council under RSA 33:3-a, II.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Concord that:

- 1) The sum of .....\$53,455.06  
be and is hereby repurposed as follows:

Wastewater Capital Project Fund  
Containment Berm Repair subproject (CIP #104).....\$53,455.06

- 2) Revenue to meet said repurposing shall be provided from the following source:

Wastewater Capital Project Fund  
Screw Pump Repair subproject (CIP #104).....\$53,455.06

- 3) Sums as repurposed shall be expended under the direction of the City Manager.

- 4) This resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
