This letter follows our recent conversation. As we discussed, we are disappointed the City did not act on the request to discontinue Old Stickney. I hope I am wrong but my gut tells me the decision was political rather than substantive. The road has not be used or available to be used for decades.

The 93 roadway widening is not a factor. I reviewed the plans and neither option impacts the existing Stickney or have any impact of the DOT property. If widened, old Stickney becomes even more useless for public travel. See the plans included. We respectfully request that the Mayor and Council take up the issue and vote it up or down with findings so we can move to the next step. Thanks.
