RESOLUTION RESCINDING AN APPROPRIATION OF NINE HUNDRED TWENTY-TWO DOLLARS AND ELEVEN CENTS (\$922.11) IN THE FIRE DEPARTMENT GOFERR GRANT PROJECT AND DE-AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF NINE HUNDRED TWENTY-TWO DOLLARS AND ELEVEN CENTS (\$922.11) IN GRANT FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE THROUGH THE GOVERNOR’S OFFICE FOR EMERGENCY RELIEF & RECOVERY (GOFERR) LOCALITY EQUIPMENT PURCHASE PROGRAM

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the Concord Fire Department was awarded grant funding from the State of New Hampshire in the amount of \$47,368 as a 90% match to purchase equipment needed as a result of or in response to the COVID19 health crisis and its negative effects; and

WHEREAS, the City Council approved Resolution #9479 on July 11, 2022 authorizing the City Manager to accept and appropriate the sum of \$47,368 in grant funding; and

WHEREAS, the Concord Fire Department expended a total of \$51,606.54 to purchase needed equipment; and

WHEREAS, the expected 90% match for \$51,606.54 is \$46,445.89; and

WHEREAS, the \$47,368 that was accepted and appropriated represents an excess of \$922.11; and

WHEREAS, this resolution rescinds and de-authorizes \$922.11 and upon passage of this resolution there will remain an appropriation of \$46,445.89.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of City of Concord that:

1. The sum of\$922.11
be and is hereby rescinded and de-authorized as follows:

2. De-authorize revenue from the following source:
