Re: Fiscal Policy Advisory Committee Recommendation to City Council for Parks and Recreation Rental Fee Waiver and Reduction

### Recommendation

Accept this report and recommendation from the Fiscal Policy Advisory Committee to not create a policy and direct the City Manager and Parks and Recreation Director to consider fee reductions and waivers on a case by case basis.

### Discussion

At the regular City Council meeting on July 14, 2025, the City Council referred a report from the Recreation and Parks Advisory Committee to request that City Council and City Administration provide a clear policy for rental fee reductions and waivers. This request was referred to the Fiscal Policy Advisory Committee for review and recommendation.

At the Fiscal Policy Advisory Committee meeting on February 17, 2026, the Recreation Director made a presentation on the fee reduction and waiver request. The Committee discussed the issue and recommended to not create a policy and have the City Manager and Parks and Recreation Director consider fee reductions and waivers requests on a case by case basis.
