RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION IN AN AMOUNT OF UP TO FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$500,000) AND TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE GRANT PROCEEDS OF UP TO FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$500,000) IN COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PUBLIC FACILITY FUNDS FOR BUILDING IMPROVEMENTS AT PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CRISIS CENTER OF CENTRAL NEW HAMPSHIRE

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The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, The Crisis Center of Central New Hampshire is a 501(c)(3) organization that provides short-term emergency shelter, as well as other services to victims of domestic violence, sexual assault, and human trafficking; and

WHEREAS, The Crisis Center of Central New Hampshire operates an emergency shelter for victims of domestic violence, sexual assault, and human trafficking, which is in need of a new heating, ventilation, and air conditioning system, as well as associated building improvements; and

WHEREAS, The Crisis Center of Central New Hampshire also has offices located at 79 South State Street, which they desire to renovate in order to better provide services to victims of domestic violence, sexual assault, and human trafficking; and

WHEREAS, the City of Concord desires to secure Community Development Block Grant Funds to assist the Crisis Center of Central New Hampshire with their proposed repairs and renovations in order to further the City's community development goals, as well as support low – moderate income persons; and

WHEREAS, the City of Concord is eligible to apply to the New Hampshire Community Development Finance Authority, Community Development Block Grant Program Division, for a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG); and

WHEREAS, this appropriation is for a purpose not included in the Fiscal Year 2020 adopted budget, therefore, section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-third vote of the City Council.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Concord that:

1. The sum of up to\$500,000
be and is hereby appropriated as follows:

CDBG Fund
Crisis Center of Central NH Project\$500,000
2. Revenue to meet said appropriation shall be provided from the following source:

CDBG Fund
CDBG grant\$500,000
3. That the City Council approves this Community Development Block Grant application and hereby authorizes the City Manager to submit the necessary grant documents and to accept, administer, and spend said CDBG funds for the purposes described herein upon approval by the NH Community Development Finance Authority.
4. Sums as appropriated shall be expended under the direction of the City Manager.
5. This resolution shall take effect upon its passage and grant award.
