RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION IN AN AMOUNT OF UP TO TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$25,300), APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$25,300.00) FOR POLICE DEPARTMENT ROADWAY SAFETY AND OUTREACH INITIATIVES AND ACCEPTING THE SUM OF TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$25,300.00) IN GRANT FUNDS FROM THE NEW HAMPSHIRE HIGHWAY SAFETY AGENCY FOR THIS PURPOSE

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the Concord Police Department seeks retroactive approval to apply for funds through the New Hampshire Highway Safety Agency for roadway safety and outreach initiatives in the amount of up to \$25,300; and

WHEREAS, the Concord Police Department has received notification from the New Hampshire Highway Safety Agency that we have been awarded a grant in the amount of \$25,300.00; and

WHEREAS, there is an in-kind match by the City in the amount of \$6,325.00 required for accepting these funds; and

WHEREAS, this match will be accounted for through administrative costs and equipment costs incurred by the Department through the life of the grant; and

WHEREAS, this appropriation is for a purpose for which funding was not included in the Fiscal Year 2025 adopted budget, therefore section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of City of Concord that:

1. The sum of\$25,300.00
be and is hereby appropriated as follows:

Grants and Donations Fund

Roadway Safety and Outreach Initiative expenses\$25,300.00

2. Revenue to meet said appropriation shall be provided from the following source:

Grants and Donations Fund

NH Highway Safety Agency Grant funds\$25,300.00

3. Sums as appropriated shall be expended under the direction of the City Manager.
4. This resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
