**Re:** Authorization to accept a gift of 13 office chairs and 3 folding tables as provided for under the pre-authorization granted by City Council.

### **Recommendation**

It is recommended that City Council approve the acceptance of the above cited gift, provided by the New Hampshire Army National Guard, with a value of approximately \$1,400.00. These chairs and tables will replace worn and non-functioning chairs currently in the Department.

### **Background**

1. No funds are requested to be expended under the authority established pursuant to resolution number 8120 adopted December 10, 2007
2. The purpose of this gift as stated above is a condition of the grantor and is consistent with and presents no conflict or obstacle to the accomplishment of City Council goals, the Code of Ordinances, or the operating functions of the department.
3. No city match is required.
4. A copy of this communication will be sent to the grantor for their information and with the thanks of the City Council and the citizens of the City of Concord.

### **Discussion**

The Concord Police Department has numerous chairs that over time have become worn and not functioning properly. The New Hampshire Army National Guard had an excess of relatively new office chairs and tables and offered to donate thirteen chairs and three tables to the police department. The estimated value of these chairs and tables is approximately \$1,400. The donated chairs will replace the most excessively worn and non-functioning chairs within Headquarters and also at the Department's sub-stations. The donated tables will be utilized in our Computer Crimes Unit and will allow space to be freed up so that additional equipment can be utilized in the Unit. It is recommended that the City Council approve the acceptance of this gift from the New Hampshire Army National Guard.
