### The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the City Council authorized the City Manager on August 8, 2022 to apply for a cyber security grant in the amount up to \$100,000; and WHEREAS, the Water Treatment Plant and the two Wastewater Treatment Plants rely heavily on technology that allows remote access for operators, and alarming protocol to reach operators immediately; and WHEREAS, General Services' Water and Wastewater divisions, in consultation with the City's Information Technology Department, completed a vulnerability assessment and identified certain measures to enhance our facilities cyber security; and the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services, through the WHEREAS, Federal American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), will provide grant funding for water and wastewater utilities not to exceed \$50,000 per utility; and

WHEREAS, there is no financial match required for this program; and

WHEREAS. this appropriation is for a purpose for which funds were not included in the Fiscal Year 2023 adopted budget, therefore Section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council to approve this Resolution.

## **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Concord that:

  - A. The City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to take such actions as may be necessary to accept funds from the NHDES for a grant through the ARPA for the purposes of the Cyber Security Improvement Projects at the Water and Wastewater Treatment Facilities;
  - B. The City Council hereby accepts the grant.
  - C. The City Council authorizes raising, appropriating, and expending the sum of up to One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) through the participation in the NHDES ARPA Program;
  - D. The City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute all documents and undertake all actions as may be required to implement this Resolution.
- 4) Sums as appropriated shall be expended under the direction of the City Manager.
- 5) This resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
