RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF ONE HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$145,475) TO CONTINUE FUNDING THE MOBILE INTEGRATED HEALTHCARE (MIH) PROGRAM ENHANCING THE CITY’S ABILITY TO RESPOND TO EMERGENCIES INVOLVING OPIOID OVERDOSES, ACCEPTING THE TERMS OF THE FIRST RESPONDER COMPREHENSIVE ADDICTION AND RECOVERY ACT (FR-CARA) GRANT, AND ACCEPTING THE SUM OF ONE HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$145,475) IN GRANT FUNDING FOR THIS PURPOSE

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the City of Concord has been awarded grant funding in the amount of \$145,475 for the FR-CARA grant implementation of Project FIRST (First Responders Initiating Recovery, Support, and Treatment); and

WHEREAS, the City of Concord desires to utilize this funding to continue initiatives for improving access to treatment for at-risk individuals and their families and support networks to access treatment information, and other resources, and to train at-risk individuals and their families and support networks on CPR and naloxone administration; and

WHEREAS, there is no financial match required for this grant program; and

WHEREAS, this appropriation is for a purpose not included in the Fiscal Year 2021 adopted budget, therefore Section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:
