Recommendation

It is recommended that the following appointments be reviewed at the March City Council Meeting for approval in April.

Background

I hereby propose moving Kevin Porter from Alternate Member status to Regular Member status, to fill a vacancy on the Conservation Commission. His current appointment will expire on January 1, 2028.

I also propose the appointment of G. Bruce Currie to fill a current vacancy as an Alternate Member of the Conservation Commission. Mr. Currie is a retired school teacher, has been a UNH Master Gardener since 2021, and is currently the Chair of the Grounds Committee at Canterbury Shaker Village. Mr. Currie will serve a three-year term to commence upon Council approval and expire on January 1, 2029. Mr. Currie's Application to Serve is attached for your information.
