**AN ORDINANCE** amending the CODE OF ORDINANCES, Title I, General Code; Chapter 9, Water, Article 9-6, Sewers and Drains

**The City of Concord ordains as follows:**

**SECTION I:** Amend the Code of Ordinances, Title I, General Code; Chapter 9, Water, Article 9-6, Sewers and Drains by adding a new Section 9-6-54, Administrative Review of Appeals of Charges or Fees Imposed, as follows:

***9-6-54 – Administrative Review of Appeals of Charges or Fees Imposed.***

*Charges or Fees imposed pursuant to this Chapter may be appealed as follows:*

- (a) The Director of General Services or his/her designee is authorized to adjudicate an appeal of charges or fees totaling \$100 or less.*
- (b) The Director of General Services or his/her designee is authorized to adjudicate an appeal contesting sanitary sewer usage charges in instances where there is satisfactory evidence that no water from the charges in question circulated into the City's sanitary sewer system.*
- (c) Notwithstanding the administrative appeal options presented in this section, an appellant not satisfied with the decision of the Director of General Services or his/her designee may still seek an appeal to the Utility Appeals Board whose decision shall be final.*

**SECTION II:** This ordinance shall take effect on adoption.
