The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the Concord Police Department has received notification from the New Hampshire Highway Safety Agency that we have been awarded a grant in the amount of up to \$61,428; and

WHEREAS, the Concord City Council approved Resolution #9074, adopted February 12, 2018, at their regular meeting authorizing the City Manager to apply for the above grant; and

WHEREAS, these funds have been designated by the New Hampshire Highway Safety Agency to be applied towards roadway safety initiatives conducted by the police department; and

WHEREAS, there is an in-kind match by the City in the amount of \$15,357 required for accepting these funds; and

WHEREAS, this match will be accounted for through administrative costs and equipment costs incurred by the Department through the life of the grant; and

WHEREAS, this appropriation is for a purpose not included in the Fiscal Year 2019 adopted budget, therefore section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:

1. The sum of\$61,428
be and is hereby appropriated as follows:

Police Overtime and Benefits\$61,428

2. Revenue to meet said appropriation shall be provided from the following source:
