Detective Julie Curtin to Receive Visionary Voice Award

The Coalition is very happy to announce that Detective Julie Curtin of Concord Police Department is this year's recipient of the National Sexual Violence Resource Center Visionary Voice Award.

Detective Curtin serves in the Criminal Investigation
Division and is a member on the Youth Services Unit.
Along with serving on the NH Attorney General's Sexual
Assault Nurse Examiner board, The Child Advocacy
Center board, and the Merrimack County Sexual Assault
Resource Team, her primary responsibilities involve
investigating cases of domestic and sexual violence. Her
dedication to seeking justice and holding perpetrators
accountable is unparalleled and her professionalism and
compassion has won her the respect and admiration of
her peers, prosecutors, advocates and the victims she
works with. Detective Curtin respects survivors and sup-

ports them in a trauma informed way that takes into account the courage it takes to come forward.
