**AN ORDINANCE** amending the CODE OF ORDINANCES, Title I, General Code; Chapter 1, Government Organization, Article 1-5, Fees, Fines, and Penalties, Schedule I

## The City of Concord ordains as follows:

**SECTION I:** Amend the CODE OF ORDINANCES, Title I, General Code; Chapter 1, Government Organization; Article 1-5, Fees, Fines, and Penalties, Schedule I, Chapter 8, Fire, by amending Section 8-4-3, Monitoring Charge, Section 8-4-8, Fire Watch, and Section 8-5-1, Emergency Medical Service Charges, as follows:
