CONCORD HOSPITAL

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the Concord Police Department desires to apply for grant funding through the

Department of Safety Homeland Security and Emergency Management Exercise

and Evaluation Program to conduct a Homeland Security Exercise; and

WHEREAS, Concord Hospital has requested the assistance of the Concord Police Department

in training and participation in critical incident type exercise at the Concord

Hospital; and

WHEREAS, Concord Hospital desires to utilize this exercise to assess the hospital's

emergency response to such an incident, and this exercise will be conducted on

Concord Hospital grounds; and

WHEREAS, there is funding available and the City of Concord is eligible to receive funding

through the Department of Safety Homeland Security and Emergency

Management Exercise and Evaluation Program to conduct such an exercise; and

WHEREAS, there is no financial match required for this grant program.

NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of City of Concord that:

- 1. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to submit the necessary grant application documents.
