Subject: 2023 Neighborhood Street Construction Project (CIP#78)

Recommendation

Accept this report appropriating \$741,002.11 from the New Hampshire Block Grant Apportionment A program for additional street paving.

Background

The City received \$741,002.11 on August 16, 2022 as an additional amount of money from the state of New Hampshire Block Grant Apportionment A program.

City Council launched the Neighborhood Street Paving Program in FY 2016, and has subsequently continued to invest in this effort for the sustained and orderly maintenance of local and neighborhood streets and sidewalks that support a vibrant community.

Since local streets have a life expectancy of 25 to 30 years, the program is predicated on a 30-year paving cycle. Streets are scheduled for work on a priority basis defined by objective measures such as pavement conditions, frequency of use, and available funding.
