WHEREAS,	the remaining proceeds of \$12,190.65 is less the remaining 10% of assessed value penalty allowed by State statute to be retained by the City; and
WHEREAS,	these funds will be used to offset future expenses that will be incurred in the taking of subsequent tax deeded property; and
WHEREAS,	this appropriation is for a purpose not included in the Fiscal Year 2017 adopted budget, therefore, Section 37 of the City Charter requires two-thirds vote of the City Council;
